Colli dei Longobardi – Strada del Vino e dei Sapori is a food and wine route that includes the city of Brescia and its Southern villages:

Flero, Poncarale, Capriano del Colle, Montirone, Castenedolo, Montichiari, Rezzato and Botticino. These are territories rich in culinary, artistic and oenological excellences. Tourists can recognize the Route thanks to the presence of visual signs and posters that identify its lands.

Museums and villas

The Route is a treasure trove of museums and ancient buildings, real flagships of the itinerary. Some of them are Pasinetti Picture Gallery, Bonoris Castle and Lechi Museum in Montichiari, Mazzucchelli Villa in Ciliverghe, the Botticino Marble Museum in Botticino and Fenaroli Villa in Rezzato. These monuments bring out even more the historical and cultural charm of Colli dei Longobardi.



Wine tourism and gastronomy



You have the desire of discovering new flavors? The Route has what it is for you! Wineries and trattorias are the best places where you can try typical products and certified wine such as Botticino DOC and Capriano del Colle DOC, IGT Montenetto di Brescia and Ronchi di Brescia. They are best savored together with local cheeses and cold cuts and the Botticino honey. The wineries have also

guided tours and events in collaboration with the best restaurants in the area in order to offer unforgettable tasting experiences!

Itineraries and tourist packages
